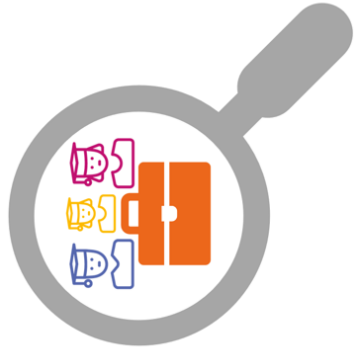

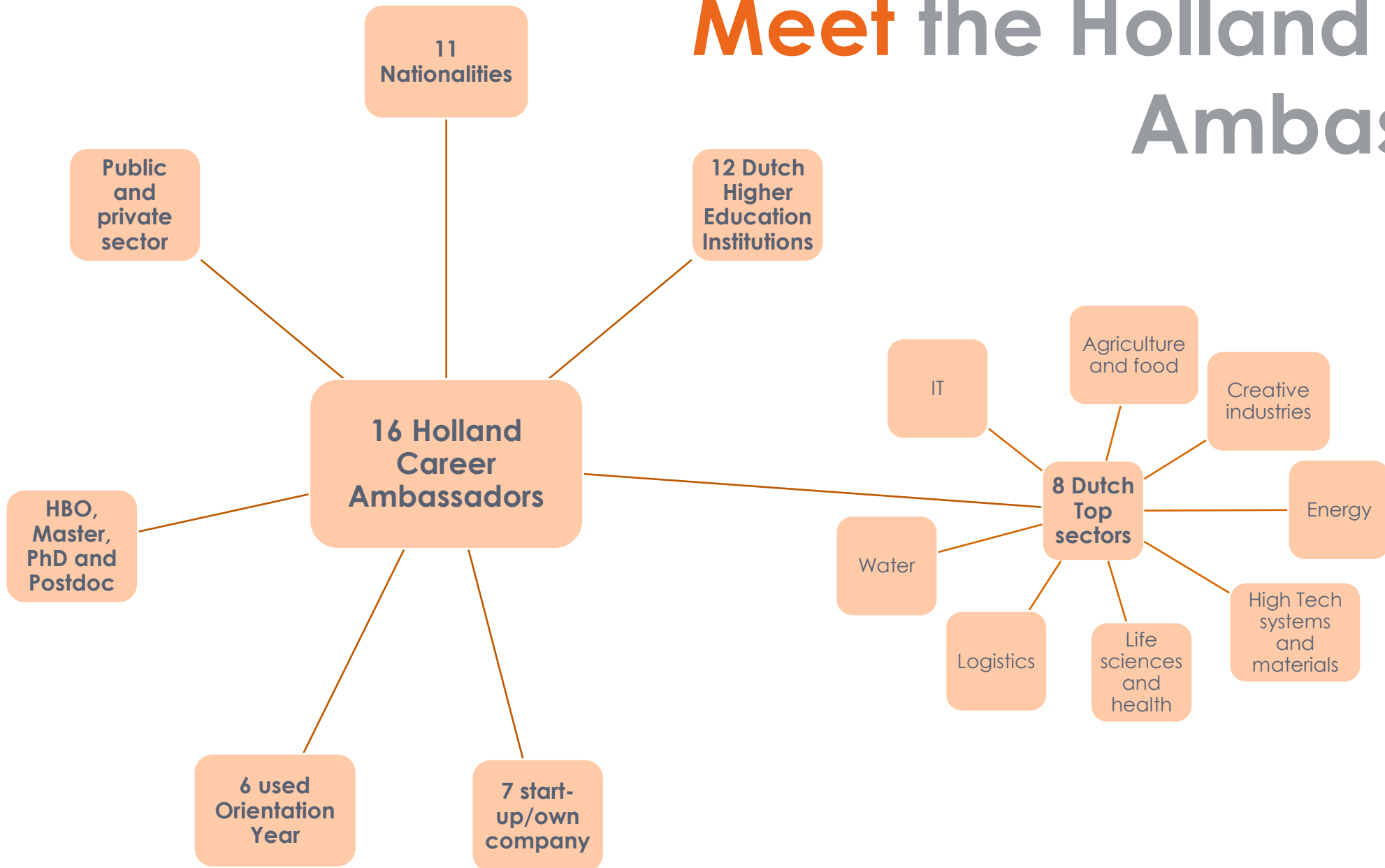

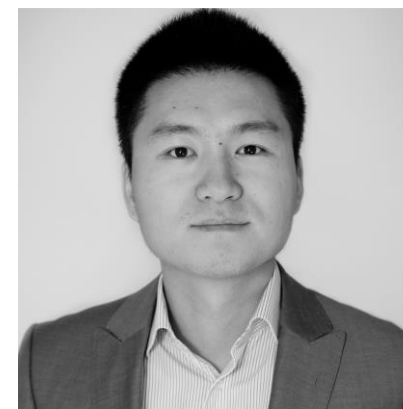

# How to request a Holland Career Ambassador

1. Check if you can meet the following criteria:
  - ✓ Reimbursement of travel costs are payed by your organisation
  - ✓ Event should have a minimum of 15 participants
2. Send in your request at least **3 weeks** before the event takes place to [jlvanveldhuizen@nuffic.nl](mailto:jlvanveldhuizen@nuffic.nl) to the attention of Ju Lin van Veldhuizen with the following information:
  - ✓ Time, date and location of event
  - ✓ Type of event and short description
  - ✓ Expected participants (amount, background)
  - ✓ Preferred (type of) Holland Career Ambassador
